PhD Candidate Sam Boucher has been awarded the Marcus Bach Graduate Fellowship for Fall 2025. Sam just finished a year-long Fulbright Study/Research grant in Paraguay doing archival research and oral interviews to help build a comparative history of the cooperative movement between the Low German Mennonites and the Indigenous Mennonites in the Gran Chaco.
